This Code of Conduct is for Club Members Under 18

East Tyrone Cycling Club in association with Cycling Ulster is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of its youth members. We believe it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with East Tyrone Cycling Club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, youth members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with a member of the coaching staff or committee member.

As a youth member of East Tyrone Cycling Club you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- Club and Cookstown High School grounds and equipment are not to be misused.
- Keep to arranged timings and locations for training and competitions: if you cannot attend or are going to be late inform a member of the coaching staff.
- Compete or participate within event rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all other club members and participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Bullying will not be tolerated in any form, either directly or by social media.
- The use of cameras or recording equipment is strictly forbidden unless permission has been given by a member of the coaching staff.
- Wear suitable kit for training, coaching and competitive sessions, as advised by the coaching staff. (I understand that a helmet is compulsory at all sessions)
- Pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Refrain from the use of inappropriate language.
